A Warm Welcome

Heswall Golf Club is a traditional private members' club which extends a very warm welcome to all visitors. Situated on the banks of the river Dee, the course was first established in 1902 but has recently been developed and extended to 6882 yards from the championship tees. It presents a variety of challenges for all standards of golfer in a uniquely beautiful setting. Home to many national and county events, Heswall was proud to successfully host the prestigious R&A Junior Open Championship in 2006 and the English Seniors Championship in 2002.

The Clubhouse

The clubhouse has recently been completely refurbished and offers outstanding views to the Welsh Hills and down the Dee Estuary to the Point of Ayre and the Irish Sea. The terrace is a great favourite of members and visitors alike. A snack menu is available during the day for the terrace, lounge and spike bar.

The upstairs dining room offers truly stunning views from its new large bay windows. It is used for formal events, club nights and social gatherings. The room is available for hire by members, friends of members and visiting societies who can be entertained after golf in great comfort.



The Course

Recently extended to 6882 yards with a SSS of 74 from the championship tees, Heswall provides a great golfing challenge for all levels of ability. The course is situated on gently sloping land either side of the 'Wirral Way', the former Neston to West Kirby railway. Designed originally by Jack Morris, the nephew of Old Tom Morris, the course has evolved over the years with input from Harry Vardon, Frank Pennick and Donald Steel. Natural woodland, lakes and streams are all very much used to create a varied and interesting layout and, when combined with the prevailing sea breeze, a real test of golf.

The 5th hole, par 5 at 605 yards, which runs adjacent to the banks of the river Dee, is one of the longest and most challenging holes in the North West of England.

Corporate and Society Days

The Professionals' Shop & Practice Facilities

Heswall Golf Club has a well stocked professionals shop supplying much of the games leading brands of golf equipment and clothing. It is located in the golf reception with trolleys and buggies available for hire. It is also home to Alan Thompson, one of the most successful golf coaches in the country. He is coach to several European Tour Professionals as well as some of the best developing talent in the United Kingdom. The practice and warm up facilities are extensive and include a range with a ball dispensing machine, a chipping green with a bunker and a putting green adjacent to the first tee.



Visitors

The locker rooms are superbly appointed and are reflective of the club's desire to provide members and visitors with exceptional facilities. Visitors are welcome in all areas of the clubhouse.
